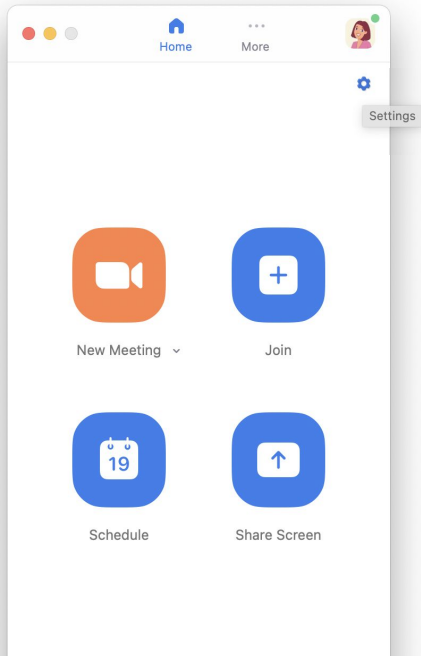

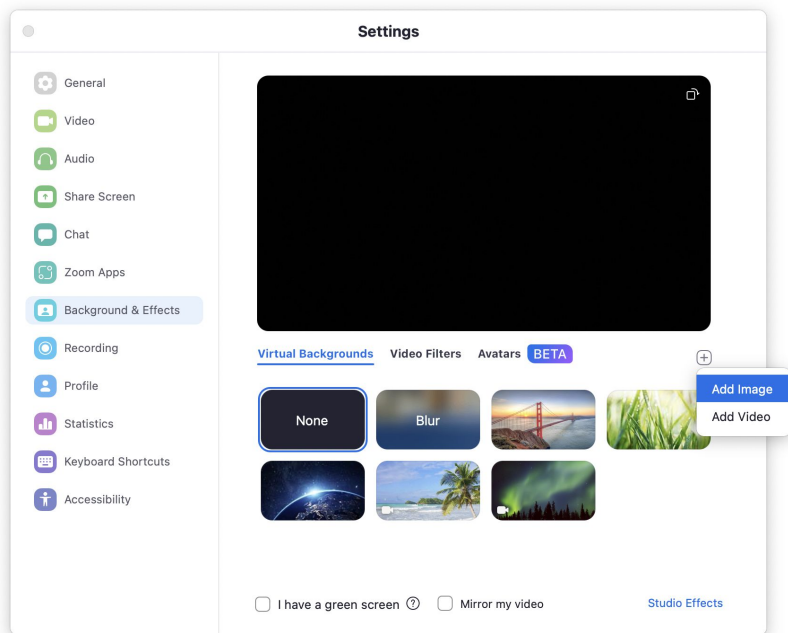

How to Set Up Your Zoom Virtual Background

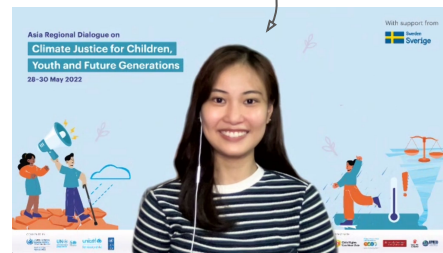
Sign in to the Zoom desktop app, and **click the**  to open Settings.
